


THE KEY OF Ab and Fm

Hello Core music folk, so today were going to continue on our journey through the different musical Keys and were going to look at the major scale of Ab and its relative minor scale of Fm. This is quite a well used key as it would often be written in G/Em and then to give it a push moved up half a fret. so here i have given you some very well known songs, all easily played with a capo on the first fret.

So the Chords in the Key of Ab are

- 1 Ab
- 2 Bbm
- 3 Cm
- 4 Db
- 5 Eb
- 6 Fm
- 7 Gdim

as you can see the relative minor is Fm




Chord shapes for piano in the key of Bbm




Ab Major Seventh




Bb Minor




